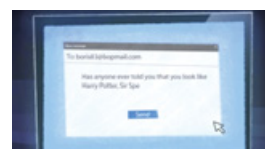

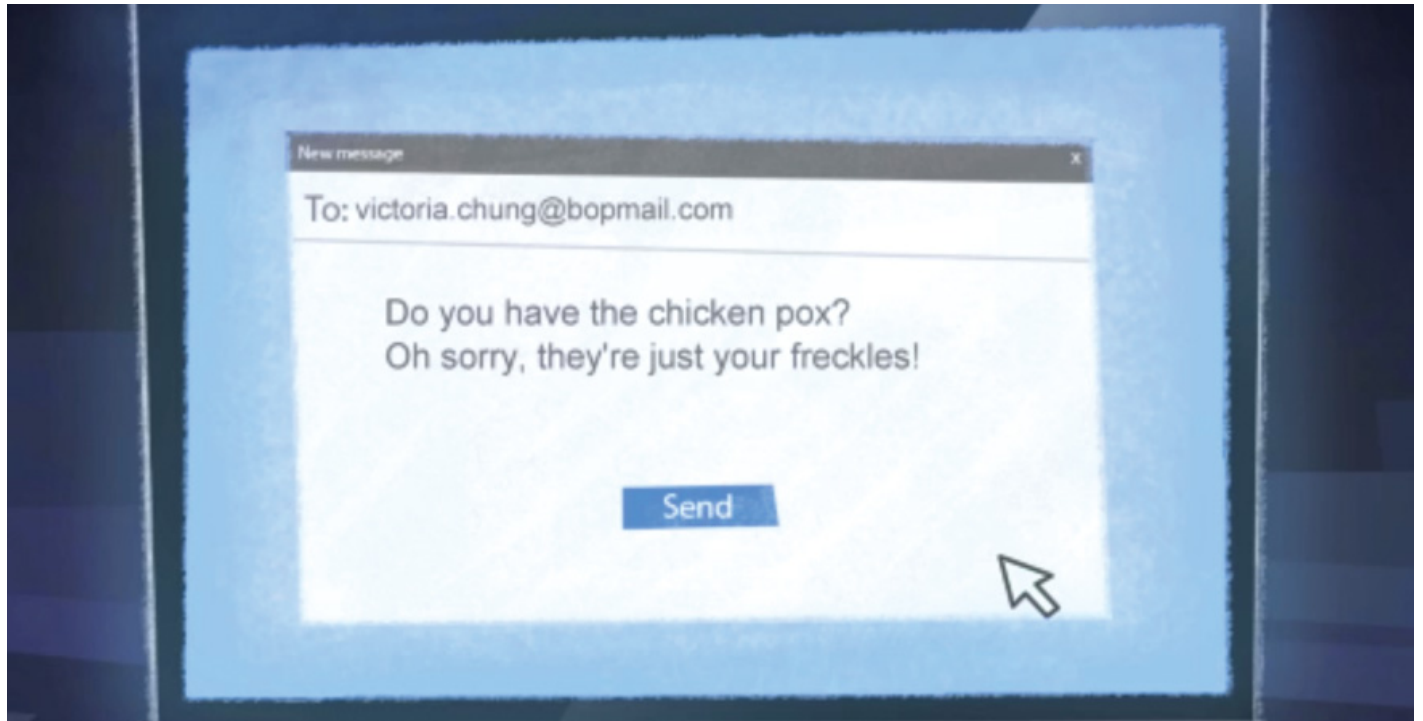

VICTORIA: Really? When was that?

NATALIA: Two years ago. One of them might win this year, too!

VICTORIA: I'd like Boris to win, but you know Alexis seems to be a good runner!

NATALIA: You're right! You and I can't run as fast as Boris, but Alexis can!

NARRATOR: Four

BORIS: I lost the race!

VICTORIA: How did that happen?

BORIS: I fell as I was about to beat Vince!

VICTORIA: Vince beat you and Alexis beat you, too! Oh, I'm so sorry, Boris, but you could've been the winner!

BORIS (SIGHS): I know... I should have put on my glasses...

NARRATOR: Five

VICTORIA: Why didn't you wear your glasses? Because of that bully who's written to you?

BORIS: When I read the e-mail, I decided not to pay attention. But then, I began to worry.

VICTORIA: You thought you would look cooler without the glasses?

BORIS: Well, yes, I did, but I was wrong!

VICTORIA: Of course you were! You didn't see that stone in the way!
