# The Treasure Chest Teacher's Guide

## Speaking Procedure

1. Greet the student. Invite him/her to sit down. Have a brief conversation as a warm-up.

### Example dialogue

T: Hello. My name's \_\_\_\_\_. What's your name?

S: (My name's) \_\_\_\_\_.

T: How old are you?

S: (I'm) \_\_\_\_\_ (years old).

2. Ask the student to name the characters on the left. Then point to the pictures on the right and elicit what each character has.

### Example dialogue

T [POINTING TO IMAGE OF PETER]: Who is this?

S: (It's) Peter.

T [POINTING TO PICTURES ON THE RIGHT]: What does Peter have?

S: (He has) a magic wand.

3. Encourage the student to say two objects per character by asking, "What else does (Peter) have?"

## Speaking Score Guide

Score 1 point for each correct name of the characters. Score 1 point for each correct item on the right-hand column.

### Very good (+)

Can name at least 2 characters and name 4 correct items from the right-hand column.

### Satisfactory (✓)

Can name at least 2 characters and name 3 correct items from the right-hand column.

### Needs additional support (-)

Can only name 1 character and say 2 correct items from the right-hand column.
