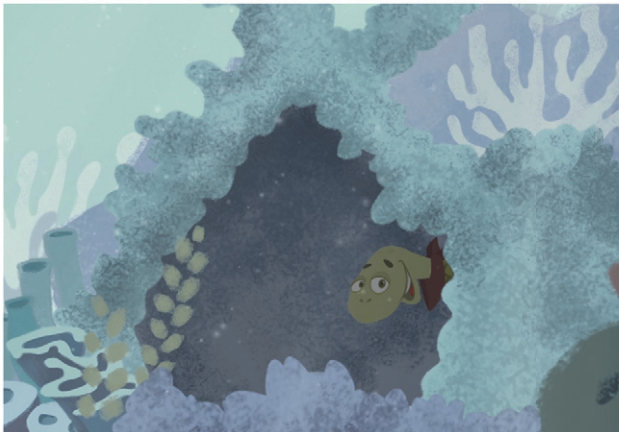

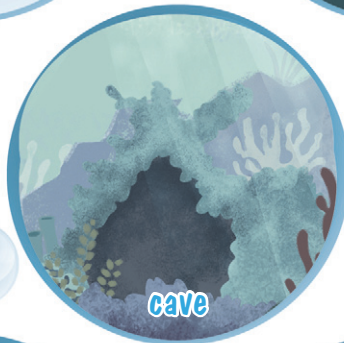

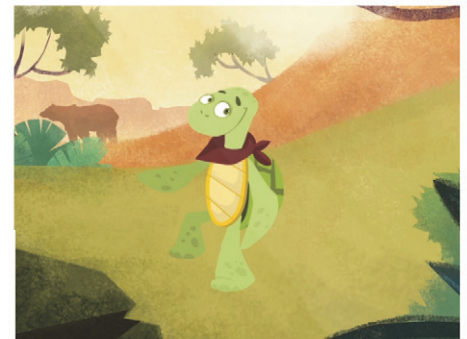

Audio Script

NARRATOR: Look at the pictures. What are they doing? Listen and look. There is one example.

MAN: What is Olive doing? Is she swinging on the swing?

WOMAN: No, she isn't swinging on the swing. Olive is playing on the monkey bars.

NARRATOR: That's right. Olive is playing on the monkey bars. Can you see the tick? Now you listen and tick the correct box.

NARRATOR: One.

MAN: What is Sammy doing? Is he making sushi?

WOMAN: Yes, he is. Sammy is making sushi.

NARRATOR: Two.

Speaking Procedure

1. Greet the student. Invite him/her to sit down. Have a brief conversation as a warm-up.

Example dialogue

T: Hello. My name's _____. What's your name?

S: (My name's) _____.

T: How old are you?

S: (I'm) _____ (years old).

2. Point to the characters at the top of the page. Say their names and encourage the student to say them with you.

3. Point to the pictures below. Tell the student to point to each one as you name them. Say "Point to the drums." Continue until most pictures have been covered.

4. Say "Look at Tim." Then point to the picture of the cave and say "Tim wants to hide in the cave." Then encourage the student to make another sentence with the same character by asking "What else does Tim want to do?" If needed, invite the student to look at the words in the box to make the sentences.

5. Point to a different character and ask "What does (Olive) want to do?"
