



















ROOMS IN A HOUSE



Instructions:

<p>1. Fold an A4 sheet in half.</p>	A photograph of a white A4 sheet of paper folded in half vertically.
<p>2. Place it horizontally and crease the center of the fold.</p>	A photograph of a white A4 sheet of paper with a horizontal crease down the center.
<p>3. Fold the left and the right parts to the center.</p>	A photograph of a white A4 sheet of paper with the left and right sides folded towards the center crease.
<p>4. Open the fold.</p>	A photograph of the paper house with the side folds opened, showing the interior.
<p>5. Press the corners to form a triangle on each side.</p>	A photograph of the paper house with the corners of the roof pressed together to form a triangular shape.
<p>6. Have the students label the rooms in the house (bedroom, bathroom, kitchen and living room) and glue the corresponding pictures (see next page) in each room.</p>	A photograph of a paper house with various rooms labeled and decorated with small drawings.
<p>7. Have the students draw a garden on the back of the house.</p>	A photograph of a paper house with a drawing of a garden on the back, including flowers and a tree.
